Sanction is hereby accorded to the following:

- A. Establishment of Civil Services Officers' Institute, J&K as a Society under Societies Registration Act, 1860.
- B. Establishment of Civil Services Officers' Institute, J&K, Jammu branch, on land identified by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu viz Khasra-9 min, Village Majheen, Tehsil Jammu.
- C. Establishment of the Civil Services Officers' Institute, J&K, (Kashmir branch) in Guest House No. 5, Maulana Azad Road, Srinagar.
- D. Provisional utilization of assets belonging to the Jammu Tawi Golf Course, Sidhra for operations of the Civil Services Officers' Institute, J&K, Jammu till infrastructure of the main campus is established.

The Governing Council of the Civil Services Officers' Institute, J&K shall be vested with powers to regulate overall functioning of the Institute and shall comprise of the following:

The following shall also be members of the Governing Council, as nominees of the Chairman of the Institute:

1. Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, J&K.
2. Mr. Dheeraj Gupta, IAS, Principal Secretary to the Government, Housing and Urban Development Department.
3. Mr. Zubair Ahmad, JKAS, Commissioner/Secretary to the Government, Department of Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs
4. Mr Sarmad Hafeez, IAS, Secretary to the Government, Tourism Department.
