WEATHER ADVISORY

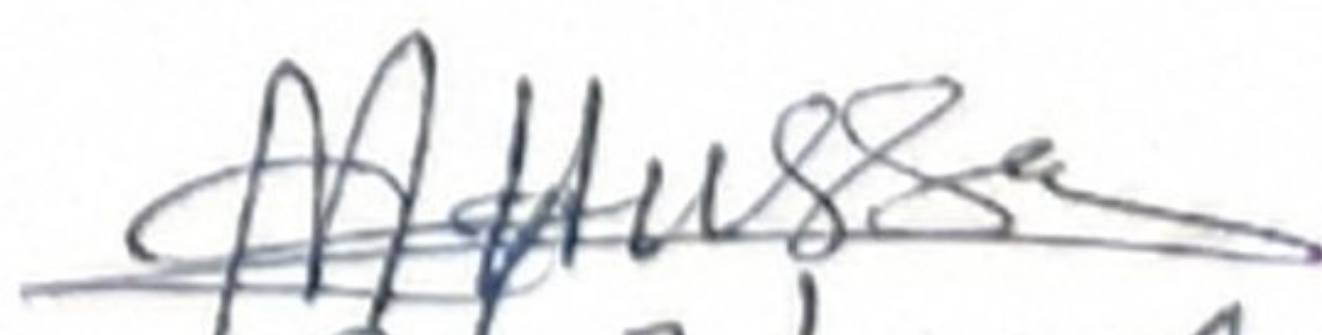
A major extended wet spell likely to impact J&K and its adjoining areas from 19th July to 23rd July 2026 forenoon due to moisture incursion from Arabian sea as well as from Bay of Bengal and the shifting of west end of Monsoon trough towards (Jammu) North of its normal position. Under the influence of this system, Widespread Moderate Rain thundershowers are expected in Jammu and Kashmir from 19th July to 23rd July 2026 with isolated heavy rains in Kashmir division from 21st to 23rd July. Scattered Heavy to very Heavy rain thundershowers (with isolated extremely heavy rain thundershowers over Reasi and Udhampur districts) in Jammu division from 20th to 23rd July, 2026.

The system is likely to cause Landslides, Mudslides, Shooting Stones, Flash Floods at Vulnerable places over Pirpanjal Range of Jammu Division and higher reaches of Kashmir Division (Anantnag, Pahalgam, Kulgam, Shopian, Pir Ki Gali, Gulmarg, Sonamarg- Zojila axis, Bandipora-Razdan Pass and Kupwara-Sadhna pass).

Probable impact:

1. This may lead to disruption of surface transport including Jammu- Srinagar National Highway and other major roads of middle & higher reaches of Jammu and Kashmir.
2. Flash floods, Torrential rains, cloud burst like events may occur during above period.
3. Significant rise in water levels in major rivers, sub-basins and streams. Chances of water logging and minor floods in low lying areas.
4. Travelers/Tourists are advised to plan accordingly in view of inclement weather.
5. People in higher reaches are asked to avoid venturing into sloppy and Landslide prone areas.
6. Farmers are advised to withheld fertilizer and chemical spray activities during the above period.
7. Significant fall in day temperature.
